

Room Snapshot.

A free AI room diagnostic — three questions,
one visual diagnosis, your moves — ranked by priority.

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Find out what's off — and exactly what to do about it.

How it works.

The Room Snapshot is a free, fast room diagnostic — built for anyone who wants to know what's actually wrong with a room and what to do first.

You answer three quick questions. Claude reads them and generates a personalized visual diagnosis right inside the chat: four category scores with sliders you can adjust, and your moves — automatically ranked so the highest-priority action is always first.

Drag a slider to recalibrate any score and the move ranking updates instantly. Click 'Details & products' under any move to expand the walkthrough and specific product picks right inline — no extra typing needed.

The whole thing — setup, questions, snapshot — takes under 10 minutes.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

A free Claude account

claude.ai — free tier works, Pro recommended

About 5-10 minutes

for setup and your first snapshot

One room in mind

any room, any size, renting or owning

Set up your Claude Project.

A Claude Project is a custom workspace where Claude remembers context. We'll create one for your Room Snapshot.

1**Go to claude.ai and sign in**

If you don't have an account, sign up — it's free.

2**Create a new Project**

On the left sidebar, click 'Projects' and '+ Create Project'. Name it 'Room Snapshot' or whatever you'd like.

3**Add the system prompt**

Inside your new Project, find 'Project instructions'. Open '01-system-prompt.txt', copy the ENTIRE contents, and paste it into that field. Save.

4**Start a new chat in the Project**

Click 'Start a new chat'. Type 'hi' or 'let's start' — Claude will ask your name, then three quick questions.

Start your Room Snapshot.

Claude will ask your name, then ask three questions. Answer them all in one message — your snapshot appears in seconds.

THE THREE QUESTIONS

01. Which room are we looking at?
02. What feels most off about it right now?
03. Are you renting or do you own?

EXAMPLE ANSWER

1. My bedroom. 2. The walls are completely blank and the lighting is harsh — it feels like a hotel room. 3. Renting.

That's it. Claude generates a four-category diagnosis with scored sliders, and your moves ranked by priority. Usually 20-30 seconds.

WHAT YOU'LL SEE

- A Room Score — your room's overall diagnostic rating
- Room Diagnosis — 4 adjustable sliders with a one-sentence read each
- Your Moves — ranked by priority, with expandable walkthrough and product picks
- A 'Go Deeper' callout — links to the full planning kits

How to save your snapshot.

Once your snapshot appears, you can download it as an HTML file to keep.

1 Look at the dashboard

This is the interactive panel that appears in the chat — not the chat window itself.

2 Find the menu

In the top-right corner of the dashboard, look for a three-dot icon or a dropdown menu. The exact look depends on how Claude renders it.

3 Click it and choose 'Download file'

A menu appears with options including 'Download file.' Click that.

4 Confirm the download

The file saves to your Downloads folder as an .html file.

5 Open in any browser

Double-click the file. Everything works — sliders, expandable sections, all of it.

TIP

The downloaded file is completely self-contained and works offline in any browser.

TWO WAYS TO EDIT

In the browser (after download): Use the Edit button to change values, then click 'Update HTML' to download a new versioned copy (v2, v3, etc.).

In Claude's chat (before download): Tell your Advisor what to change. It will regenerate the dashboard with your updates. Then download the new version.

Important: Edits in Claude's chat won't transfer to the download, and vice versa. Pick one flow: download first and edit in the browser, or finalize with your Advisor first.

What to do next.

Your snapshot is the starting point. You can keep talking with Claude to go further. Here's what works well:

Walk through a move

"Walk me through Move 1 in detail." / "What exactly should I look for in a floor lamp?"

Recalibrate your scores

"Actually my lighting is fine — drag that up to 4." / "Storage is way worse than 2, more like 1."

Get product recommendations

"Find me a warm floor lamp under \$40." / "Where do I get Command strips in bulk?"

Find art that fits

"What kind of art would work in this room?" Claude knows about Alex Neo Home art collections.

WANT A FULL PLAN?

The Room Snapshot shows what's off. The full kits build out the complete plan — priority matrix, budget tracker, phased strategy, and more. Find them at alexneohome.com

Troubleshooting.

Claude shows code instead of a visual dashboard

Tell Claude: "That showed up as code, not a visual. Can you try again?"

The Edit button doesn't work

Tell Claude: "The Edit button isn't working — can you regenerate with a working Edit button?"

The downloaded file looks different from the dashboard

Make sure you're connected to the internet the first time you open the file, so the fonts can load.

The Update HTML button doesn't work inside Claude's chat

That's expected. The Update HTML button only works after you've downloaded the file and opened it in a real browser. Use the three-dot menu to download first.
